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## 1. OPEN DISCUSSION

**Melissa Grimes (Housing Authority)** announced that the HA has current openings at Ambridge Towers for those aged 45 years and older OR those younger than 45 who have a disability. Openings are also available at Sheffield for those aged 62 years or older.

**Don Walker (Head Start/Early Head Start)** announced two recruiting events taking place today from 10 am – 6 pm. They will take place at New Brighton High School and 521 8<sup>th</sup> Street in Ambridge. The Ambridge location is opening a new classroom this year.

**Nancy Greico (American Red Cross)** reported 1 house fire since the last meeting which involved 4 adults and 1 minor. She reported that everyone has been successfully linked to services/resources.

**Harry Angelo** (Emergency Rental Assistance Program) reminded the group that the ERAP program is only for tenants not for homeowners. Dina reminded the group that the PA Homeowners Assistance funds is still available for those who have already applied. Cyndi Gilkey from neighborhood legal Services noted that there is a new portal for the Homeowners program - <https://pahaf.org/>. ## 2. AGENDA

### **Home4Good Request Submitted**

**Dina Ciabattoni (CoC Coordinator)**

Dina reported that the Home4Good proposal has been submitted to PHFA and the Pittsburgh Federal Home Loan Bank. She stated \$37,650 was applied for on behalf of the Salvation Army for their landlord engagement and furniture program. Another \$12,700 was applied for on behalf of Housing Opportunities for rental assistance for two transitional housing units for homeless/near homeless households. PHFA stated they will make the announcement in December.

### **PREP Training**

**Heather Slaughter (SDHP)**

Heather shared that the PREP training is designed to help staff better assist their clients to secure and maintain housing by being a prepared renter. She reminded the group that the in-person training is scheduled for 8/24 from 1pm – 4pm at BCBH. She stated that materials will be available electronically so attendees can print what they need. ### **Outreach & Fair Housing Position**

**The Cornerstone of Beaver County**

Marie announced that The Cornerstone has combined the outreach and fair housing positions. She stated that they expect this change to provide a greater impact on outreach and community engagement and education. Fair Housing had previously been tied to the inspector position. She stated that this new position is full-time and comes with benefits. She also noted that the Men's Emergency Shelter is also hiring. Marie also mentioned that the Office on Aging recently reported an increase in evictions of their clients with pets.

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## **OUTREACH COORDINATOR**

### **Job Posting**

The Cornerstone of Beaver County (TCBC) is a 501c3 nonprofit located in Beaver Falls, PA. TCBC is hiring a full-time (40hrs per week) Outreach Coordinator, whose standard work hours are completed Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. The position is primarily site-based at The Cornerstone of Beaver County located at 600 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Beaver Falls, PA 15010 with offsite traveling as needed. This is a one-year grant funded position.

This position will:

- Provide case management to clients who are waiting to receive housing services.
- Conduct homeless outreach in the community to engage households that otherwise may not have access to needed services. These services include shelters, accessing coordinated entry, food banks/pantries, employment, etc.
- Transport homeless clients as needed to shelter and other social service agencies both in and out of the County.
- Respond to community concerns regarding homeless households that need immediate assistance.
- Maintain a working knowledge of locations where homeless households spend time.
- Assist with planning of all homeless outreach efforts.
- Participate in all homeless outreach efforts.
- Play an active role in planning and carrying out the yearly Point in Time survey.
- Serve as the Beaver County Fair Housing Officer
- Other duties as assigned.

## Description of Beaver County Supportive Housing Programs

**Community Assisted Residential Living (C.A.R.L.)** is a permanent supportive housing program for homeless households with a disability. It is a tenant based rental model administered by the Housing Authority of Beaver County. The Program focuses on households with the longest length of homelessness, homeless households with children, veterans, and victims of domestic violence. Individuals and families live in scattered sites. The program is not funded to provide case management services. **Crescent Commons** is a permanent supportive housing program administered by the Housing Authority of Beaver County which provides housing vouchers to participants who are chronically homeless with disabilities and who have exhausted all other housing options. At full operational capacity the program should house approximately 31 people. Individuals and families live in scattered sites. The program is not funded to provide case management services. **Friendship Homes** is a 33 bed scattered permanent supportive housing program administered by the Salvation Army for both chronically homeless and non-chronically homeless individuals and families and with disabilities. In addition to housing, the program is funded to provide moderate case management services. **Stone Harbour** is a transitional supportive housing program administered by Cornerstone Recovery and Supports (CRS) which provides supportive housing for 12 chronically homeless individuals struggling with co-occurring disorders of mental illness and substance abuse, as well as those with legal histories. Individuals live in a single site in Freedom PA. The program is funded to provide on-site case management services. Contact information: Marcy Scott: [mscott@crscare.org](mailto:mscott@crscare.org)

**Salvation Army Rapid Re-Housing** is a medium term rapid re-housing program for homeless households who score for rapid re-housing through Coordinated Entry and who need longer term financial assistance (up to 2 years). Individual assessment will determine length of financial support and types of supportive services offered. **Safely Home** is a medium term rapid re-housing program for homeless households fleeing DV situations. The Women's Center will also provide support to clients. 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### 811 Program (not a McKinney Vento program)

A subsidized housing program for disabled adults (age 18-61) who are either in an institution or at risk of institutionalization and who are able to reside in the community with supports. Criteria include:

- Disabled and Medicaid eligible. Also eligible for long-term services and supports
- Income at or below 30% AMI
- Eligible for the Housing Authority





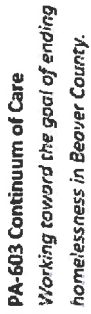
